

GLD 201 Discovering the Workplace
Open, Grade 10

This course provides students with opportunities to discover and develop the workplace essential skills and work habits required to be successfully employed. Students will develop an understanding of work through practical hands-on experiences in the school and in the community, using real workplace materials. They investigate occupations of interest through experiential opportunities (e.g., worksite visits, hearing guest speakers, job shadowing, work experience, simulations, and entrepreneurial projects). This course helps students make plans for continued learning and work.

GLC 20W + ENG 2 W Subject Related Co-operative Education 2 Credit Package

Open, Grade 11, 12

This course is closely associated with the contents and skills of an in-school subject, which the student has completed or is currently completing. The student is placed in a work placement to work three hours a day. The work experience will enable the student to incorporate the course objectives of the in-school subject in to the work placement, improve employability skills and explore educational and career paths. Evaluation is based on workplace performance, integrated assignments, journals and personal commitment. Students must be 16 years of age and be selected through an interview process

Open, Grade 11, 12

This course is closely associated with the contents and skills of an in-school subject, which the student has completed or is currently completing. The student is placed in a work placement to work three hours a day. The work experience will enable the student to incorporate the course objectives of the in-school subject in to the work placement, improve employability skills and explore educational and career paths. Evaluation is based on workplace performance, integrated assignments, journals and personal commitment. Students must be 16 years of age and be selected through an interview process

They will make plans for continued learning and work, work with others to design learning experiences, and investigate the resources and support required to make a smooth transition to their postsecondary destination.
